Parade Rules

- 1. Registration begins at 7:30AM on Saturday, February 28, 2015 at the tennis courts at the 1400th block of Milam Street. **All participants must check in by 8:45AM.**
- 2. Judging is from 9 to 9:45AM, all entries must be in place, set-up, and riders must be on the entry until judging is complete. **Remember participation counts.**
- 3. The parade starts at 10:30AM, all driver(s) and participants must be ready to begin moving by 10:20AM. **Rain or Shine**
- 4. All automobiles and large vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver.
- 5. Floats and entries must be in good taste and considered appropriate for spectators. Loud or vulgar remarks and profanity **WILL NOT** be tolerated from parade participants. Any violations of this will result in immediate removal from parade.
- 6. All equine entries must have proof of current negative EIA test within the last 12 months.
- 7. The Columbus FFA Alumni, Columbus FFA Chapter, Parade Chairman, and/or Committee members assume **NO** responsibility for accidents or loss of any kind.
