SUBJECT: Texas Fairs and Events Education Foundation \$2000 Scholarship

Applicants must:

1. Read the scholarship requirements.

- 2. Provide all information on the two-page application. Do not return these guidelines with the application.
- 3. Answer all questions and supply all supporting data. <u>Failure to do so will result in disqualification/consideration for scholarship award</u>.
- 4. Sign the application.
- 5. Be a U.S. citizen.
- 6. Mail application materials in one envelope to ensure receipt of all information. <u>Special folders and presentation are not needed and are not viewed by the scholarship committee</u>.
- 7. Submit a **one-page essay** as to why you deserve a scholarship.
- 8. Have participated actively in a local fair or event.
- 9. Rank in the upper 33% of his/her class.
- 10. Furnish official transcript of his/her high school record. The college entrance scores, size of class and rank in the class should be entered on this transcript and the transcript should include data through mid-year of the applicant's senior school year.
- 11. Provide a recent photograph or clear snapshot to the Foundation office with application.
- 12. Furnish a letter of recommendation from his/her high school principal that addresses applicant's general qualifications and character.
- 13. Provide a letter of recommendation from the Texas fair or event nominating the applicant for a scholarship. This Texas fair or event must be a member in good standing of the Texas Association of Fairs and Events (TAF&E). Each active TAF&E member organization may submit **one** scholarship applicant. Multiple applications will result in the disqualification of all applicants from that member organization.
- 14. Be a graduate from a Texas high school during the year of application and attend a college or a university the following fall and spring semesters.
- 15. Attend an accredited college or university and enroll for and complete a minimum of 12 hours per semester. A GPA of 2.50 is required to receive the second and final scholarship installment.
- 16. Receive scholarship payments (if chosen) as scheduled by the Foundation. Please make other arrangements if receipt of Foundation scholarship payment conflicts with other scholarships, grants or financial aid received.
- 17. If chosen, the <u>student</u> assumes the main responsibility of communication with the TAF&E office and must supply a valid email address and phone number to be reached while in college.
